Arts Center Rental

The historic NOTO Arts Center located at 935 N. Kansas Ave was originally built as a federal post office in 1938. It is a Classical Revival architectural style building with detailing in the window arches and a glass fanlight window over entry. Starting in the early 1980's the building was used by various businesses until it was purchased and donated by Stan and Jody Teeter in 2014 to serve as an arts center.

The NOTO Arts Center offers a unique and versatile venue for meetings, workshops and small events. The facility may be set in multiple options to serve your unique needs and includes use of all common areas, including the Brewster Community Room, the Morris Art Gallery, the foyer, and a small serving kitchen. Use of various types and sizes of tables and chairs are included; linens are available for an additional fee. A NOTO Arts Center staff member is present for all rentals to ensure the event is trouble-free.
