

# Morris Gallery Annual Fiber Art Juried Show, NOTO ARTS DISTRICT 2022

March/April 2023

**THEME: SEASONS** - An expression in fiber art of a season or multiple seasons. Captivate viewers with a view of seasons and what that means to you as an artist.

**ACCEPTED TYPES OF ART:** 2D and 3D work will be accepted

**DESCRIPTION OF ACCEPTABLE WORK:** Fiber work includes artwork created with cloth, fiber from an animal such as wool, silk, alpaca or llama or fiber from a plant-based product such as cotton or linen. All work must be original work by the artist and can have no verbiage that is copyrighted on the artwork. The artwork should have been completed within the last 3 years.

**OPEN TO:** Entrants within the continental United States.

**SIZE:** No work should exceed 24" X 36" in size for 2D (minimum size is 12" X 12") or 15" Square and no taller than 36" tall for 3D work.

**SUBMISSION PHOTOS:** We request 2 photos of each work one of the overall work with the edges viewable and one close-up photo of the work (artist's choice). These should be 300 DPI. Please label the photos with artist name, and name of work, overall or close-up (Example: AnnSmith-Spring-Overall)

**SUBMISSION INFORMATION:** Please give a brief description of each piece submitted.

**# OF WORKS ACCEPTED:** Artists can submit up to 3 pieces of artwork to be juried.

**ENTRIES DUE:** January 10, 2023

**ARTWORK DUE TO THE NOTO ARTS CENTER IF NOTIFIED OF SELECTION FOR THE SHOW:** Between February 7, 2023, and February 21, 2023. Artwork can be hand delivered during business hours to 935 N. Kansas Ave., Topeka, KS 66608 or shipped to 4612 NE Indian Creek, Topeka KS 66617, Attn: Fiber Art Exhibit. Art being shipped must come in a container that the art can be returned in with return postage included. All work that is shipped is to be insured by the artist for all shipping. Any artwork not received by February 21, 2023, at the NOTO Arts Center will not hang in the exhibit for 2023.

## ENTRY DETAILS:

All artworks must be for sale during the exhibit. The artist will submit the work with their desired retail price. NOTO Arts Center will handle all sales of the artwork during the exhibit and will take 40% commission.

All artworks must remain on exhibit in the gallery for the duration of the exhibit.

Entrants must be 18 years or older.

All artworks must be appropriate for all audiences.

All work must be ready to hang for the show. Quilted non-framed art must have a hanging sleeve and board with wire to hang the piece of work. Framed work should have a wire across the back to hang the work. 3D work will be placed on pedestals in the gallery.

Opening reception will be Thursday March 2, 2023, with the Friends of NOTO. The opening reception is from 5 – 7 PM. On March 2, 2023, we will have the awards ceremony for Best of Show and Merit awards both selected by the Juror. All decisions by the juror are final. For the 2 months of the exhibit, there will be voting by gallery guests, and a viewer's choice ribbon and award will be given at the end of the exhibit.

First Friday March 3, 2023, will be the opening of the Fiber Art Show "Seasons" to the public. Artists are invited to be present to visit with the public about their art.

All artworks will be available for pick up May 3, 2023, and can be picked up until May 12, 2023.

**Responsibility for Loss or Damage, Insurance Coverage.** Gallery will exhibit utmost care for the safekeeping of all consigned Artworks while they are in its custody. An insurance provision for loss or damage is the responsibility of the Artist. Gallery maintains a liability policy with the landlord of the project but does not provide content insurance. **Artist should insure their own work.**

**ENTRY FEE:** \$35 for the first piece entered and \$10 for each additional entry. Please pay your fees at <https://explorenoto.org/product/juried35/>

Coming full circle back to Kansas, she cemented her love of clay by attaining her MFA from Wichita State University and studying contemporary art in New Zealand. After teaching ceramics for 8 years at Washburn University she wanted to share clay with the emerging arts community starting Fire Me Up Ceramics & Fine Art Studios in 2018.
